## Rules & Conditions

- No unauthorized riding in the main area of Pandy Show.
- **First aid £2.50 per rider.**
- The show committee shall not be responsible for any accident to exhibitor or exhibit
- The judge's decision is final
- Championship trophies remain the property of the show committee whilst in the possession of the winning exhibitor. They should be returned in good condition 4 weeks before the date of the show of the following year.
- All objections must be lodged at the secretary then **NO LATER THAN 30 MINUTES AFTER THE END OF THE CLASS**, with a deposit of £20 to be returned if the objection is upheld. All objections must be in writing.
- Safety hats to Standard PAS 015:1998 with BSI kitemark, VG1 with BSI kitemark, Snell E2001 onwards, ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with SEI mark or AS/NZS 3838, 2003 or 2006 and suitable footwear must be worn by all competitors
- Jacket or body protector to standards BETA 2009 Level 3 must be worn in all jumping classes
- No galloping or mistreatment of animals will be allowed
- The committee reserves the right to alter or omit any part of the program
- No horse or pony to be left unattended or tied to a lorry or trailer
- Stallions to be ridden or handled by 16 year olds or over
- Best in show to go forward to parade in main ring

# **RING ONE**

## **Ridden Classes**

Judge: Mr P Brown

**9am Start**

**Entry Fee: £6 per class**

**Class 1.** Best turned out

**Class 2.** Lead rein pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 12hh. Rider to be 3 years old and under 8 years old on 01/01/2018

**Class 3.** First ridden pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 12.2hh. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 01/01/18

**Class 4.** Local Equitation horse or pony 4 years old or over. Conformation and sex will not be taken into account, the class will be judged 60% on the rider and 40% on the horse's manners, obedience and way of going. Horses and ponies will be asked to walk, trot and canter on each rein and rider will be asked to give a short display of their own choice. Special rosette for pony club member. (Lead rein permitted)

**Class 5.** Pony of show hunter type, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not to exceed 15.0hh. Lead rein and ridden entries accepted. Rider to be correct age for height of horse.

**Class 6.** Open ridden Horse/Pony, 4 years old or over.

**Class 7.** Ridden or In Hand horse or pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, coloured, spotted, appaloosa, or palomino.

**Class 8.** Best ridden or In Hand veteran horse or pony, over 15 years. Special rosette for over 25 years.

**Class 9.** Open hunter.

**1st and 2nd Prize winners in classes 1-9 go forward for championship. Champion and reserve champion go forward to Supreme Championship**

## **RING TWO**

Open to any breed, type or colour

**9.00am Start**

**Entry Fee: £6 per class**

**Class 10.** Open young stock 3 years old and under

**Class 11.** Open mare (optional foal at foot in hand)

**Class 12.** Open gelding

**Class 13.** Stallion 4 years old and over

**Class 14a.** Young handler 8 and under

**Class 14b.** Young handler 12 and under

(If insufficient entries classes 14a & 14b will be combined.)

**1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winner in classes 10 to 14a&b go forward for the championship. Champion and reserve go forward for Supreme Championship.**

**Entry Fee: £6 per class**

**Class 21.** Mountain and moorland leading rein pony, mare or gelding, not exceeding 12hh, 4 years old or over. Rider not to have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> Birthday on 01/01/18.

**Class 22.** Mountain and moorland, first ridden pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 12.2hh. Rider not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday on 01/01/18.

**Class 23.** Mountain and moorland small and large breeds. Rider any age. Judged separately if sufficient entries.

**Class 24.** Mountain and moorland to be shown in hand, small and large breeds. Judged separately if sufficient entries.

**1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 21 to 24 go forward for the championship. Champion and reserve go forward for the best in show.**

## **RING THREE**

**Working Hunter**

**Entry Fee: £6 per class**

**Class 25.** Mini. Jumps 1'3 (Lead rein or assistance permitted)

**Class 26.** Open, Jumps 1'6 (Lead rein or assistance permitted)

**Class 27.** Open, Jumps 2'0

**Class 28.** Open, Jumps 2'3

**Class 29** Open, Jumps 2'6

**Class 30.** Open, Jumps 2'9

**1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 25 to 30 go forward to the championship. Champion and reserve champion will go forward to best in show.**

**Not to start before 1:30pm**

**Class 35.** Cross poles (Lead rein permitted)

**Class 36.** 1'6 (Lead rein permitted)

**Class 37.** 2'0 Open
